

Purchase Agreement Checklist

Some (but not necessarily all) information we will need before sending a purchase agreement and starting a job is listed below. Please note these items and have the information available when you are ready to move forward with your cabinet order. Please remember that your installation timeline does not start until we have all of the following applicable information and a signed purchase agreement.

_____ Full list of all applicable appliances and flooring types

_____ We must agree on all applicable measurements, layouts, and cabinet drawings.

_____ Door style selection – We can custom build a few select door styles for small projects, but we order most of our doors from [Cabinet Components Incorporated](#). Our standard pricing is based on a cope & stick door with a 1/4" plywood center panel. Raised panel, mitered, or applied molding doors are an upgrade.

_____ Finish selections:

Paint – All color selections.

For Custom: We can directly match any Sherwin Williams or Benjamin Moore color. We will need a color sample to match provided by you (customer) for any other paint color selection.

For Wellborn Forest: We need a signed Finish Agreement with listed paint finish

Stain – All species and color selections

Custom: We can use any interior oil based stain. (Please see your local paint store for any custom stain color selection. Any custom stain must be reproduceable)

_____ Crown molding selection – single run standard size crown molding in a variety of styles is standard. Large or multi piece crown molding is an upgrade.

_____ Hardware selections – We will need all style, finish, and placement selections. We sell HardwareResources.com hardware. We can also install hardware you provide.

Please note that hardware installation cost can vary with hardware mounting type. We will need your hardware selection even if you chose to supply your own. If you do supply your own hardware and do not have the selection ready at the time of cabinet order there may be an additional fee depending on the mounting type. Also, If the hardware is not provided to us on the day of installation there may be an added return trip fee.

_____ Drawer box selection – Dovetail drawer boxes with soft close undermount runners are standard on most cabinets. Please specify if you would like plywood boxes with side mount runners.

_____ Hinge type – We use compact concealed soft close hinges as standard. Exposed hinges are an upgrade and must be requested and style/finish agreed upon.

_____ Door overlay – Do you prefer full overlay, partial overlay, or inset doors? Our default is full overlay. Inset doors are an upgrade. (full and partial overlay doors are the same cost)

_____ Light rail selection (if applicable) – this is the decorative trim under wall cabinets that hides lighting fixtures. Please see HardwareResources.com for some options. *This is an upgrade option.

_____ Decorative toe kick, base molding, or feet selections (if applicable) *This is an upgrade option.

_____ Glass type (if applicable) – Glass is an upgrade option. Cabinet Designs can only supply clear glass. Other types of glass are to be supplied and installed by the contractor or homeowner. *Decorative grids are an extra upgrade option and may affect door style availability.

_____ Hood style (if applicable) – Please send us your preferred custom hood style in the form of a drawing or picture that we can re-create along with any relevant notes.
